

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



Please make sure that you fulfill the entry requirements for each port of your cruise.

If there is any doubt, please contact the consulate of said country to check the current entry requirements.

Your Passport has to be valid at least 6 months after the end of your voyage for all countries, regardless of destination. Please also make sure that you have enough free pages in your passport available.

The following entry requirements are only **relevant to German, Austrian, French, Finish, Danish, Swedish, Norwegian and Icelandic citizens**:

<b>Australia</b>	Online	An eVisitor visa or an ETA (electronic entry permit) is required to enter Australia, this also applies for transit visitors. Cost: eVisitor visa currently free of charge / ETA approx. 20 AUD <a href="https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-listing/evisitor-651">https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/visas/getting-a-visa/visa-listing/evisitor-651</a>
<b>Indonesia</b>	Online or on arrival	“Visa on arrival” or ‘electronic visa on arrival’ in advance <a href="https://evisa.imigrasi.go.id/">https://evisa.imigrasi.go.id/</a> Costs: 500,000 IDR (approx. 30 EUR / as of July 2024)
<b>Cambodia</b>	At embassy or upon arrival	At the embassy: fee approx. 40 EUR + passport photo for the visa On arrival: Fee approx. 55 USD + passport photo for the visa The e-visa, which can now also be applied for, only allows entry via a limited number of border crossings, so it is currently not recommended.
<b>Canada</b>	Online	An entry permit is required for entry by air. Costs: 7 CAD (approx. 5 EUR). <a href="http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp">http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp</a> The ETA is not required for entry by sea or land.
<b>New Zealand</b>	Online	An electronic entry permit NZeTA is required to enter New Zealand. NZeTA must also be applied for a stay in the transit area. Costs for NZeTA via the website currently NZD 23 Costs for NZeTA via the app currently 17 NZD <a href="https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas/visas/visa/nzeta">https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas/visas/visa/nzeta</a> When applying for the NZeTA, a tourist levy (International Visitor Conservation Levy - IVL) of currently 35 NZD (approx. 20 EUR) is also charged.
<b>Papua New Guinea</b>	Upon arrival	The visa is free of charge when entering the country by cruise ship.

<b>Philippines</b>	Upon arrival	Entry for tourism and business purposes as well as official visits and transit are possible with a “Visa on Arrival”. A “visa on arrival” is affixed to the passport by the border police in the form of an entry stamp upon entry with an indication of the possible duration of stay, which is a maximum of 30 days.
<b>Singapore</b>	Health declaration (online within 3 days before entry)	All travelers must complete a free, electronic arrival card via the <a href="#">Immigration and Checkpoint Authority</a> website within three days of planned entry.
<b>South Korea (Republic of Korea)</b>	Online	Pre-registration for a <a href="#">K-ETA</a> is required, certain nationalities are exempted.
<b>Thailand</b>	Online	The Thai government has announced the introduction of an ETA (electronic entry permit) for summer 2025.
<b>USA</b>	Online	An electronic travel authorization must be applied for at <a href="https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta">https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta</a> . In addition, the dates of birth must be submitted to the airline. Guests who have stayed in <b>Cuba after January 2021</b> require a visa. Dual nationals who also have the nationality of Iraq, Iran, Cuba, North Korea, Syria or Sudan, as well as travelers who have stayed in Iraq, Iran, Yemen, Libya, North Korea, Somalia, Sudan or Syria after 01.03.2011 require a visa. <b>ESTA is also required for transit</b> , i.e. as soon as you enter the USA. Also for e.g. stopover and direct onward flight to a third country).
<b>Vietnam</b>	Online, an Bord oder bei der Botschaft	<b>German, French, Danish, Swedish, Norwegian &amp; Finish citizens: no visa required</b> Icelandic nationals: E-Visa (Single Entry: 25 USD/ Multiple Entry: 50 USD). Visa on board: fee approx. 56 USD - a passport photo and a copy of the passport must also be submitted. Alternative: classic visa via the embassy.
<b>United Kingdom</b>	Online	An Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) will be required from 2 April 2025. An application for an ETA can be made via the following link: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/guidance/apply-for-an-electronic-travel-authorisation-eta">https://www.gov.uk/guidance/apply-for-an-electronic-travel-authorisation-eta</a> The ETA will be subject to a fee: GBP 10

Travelers under 21 years:

- For tourists under 21 travelling alone, there are specific entry requirements for each country. We kindly ask you to contact the embassy/consulate for specific information.
- For under aged travelers with a family name different from their parents, a proof of family relation is required (e.g. a birth certificate).

**We recommend all passengers to carry a copy of their passport as well as further electronic travel authorizations with them at all times**

**We recommend considering travel insurance including international travel health insurance and repatriation.**

**For trips including a stopover in New Caledonia, it is mandatory to proof international travel health insurance covering cruises.**

**Please make sure you have all current information about vaccinations as well. Yellow Fever vaccination can be required at certain ports.**
